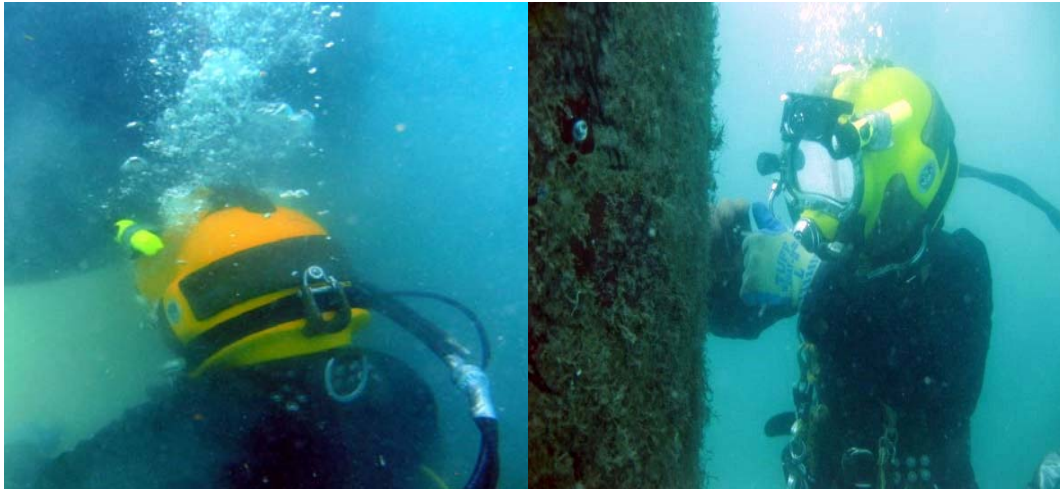

LOGAN DIVING & SALVAGE COMPLETES NAVFAC TRIDENT WHARF QUALITY CONTROL INSPECTIONS

LOGAN DIVING & SALVAGE RECENTLY COMPLETED QUALITY CONTROL INSPECTIONS OF THE RECENTLY COMPLETED TRIDENT WHARF STRUCTURAL IMPROVEMENTS.

TRIDENT WHARF, LOCATED ON CCAFS, WAS INITIALLY CONSTRUCTED FROM 1975-1977 AND IS AN OPERATIONAL NAVFAC FACILITY IN SUPPORT OF THE U.S. NAVY FLEET BALLISTIC MISSILE SUBMARINE PROGRAM.

ALL DIVE TEAM MEMBERS MET SECURITY CRITERIA AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS OF THE USN AND USN DIVING COORDINATOR. LOGAN DIVING & SALVAGE ALSO WAS DEEMED QUALIFIED THRU THE FEDERAL USN EM-385 COMMERCIAL DIVING STANDARDS AND WERE VETTED THRU THE USN DIVE QUALIFICATION MATRIX.

DIVING OPERATIONS WITH A 4 MAN SURFACE SUPPLIED DIVE TEAM WERE CONDUCTED TO ENSURE STRUCTURAL ELEMENTS EVIDENCED NO DEFECTS AFTER INSTALLATION. ALL DIVING OPERATIONS WERE DOCUMENTED WITH TOPSIDE MONITORED COLOR DVD UNDERWATER VIDEO. INSPECTIONS WERE PHASED TO COINCIDE WITH CONSTRUCTION BENCHMARKS COMPLETED. ALL INSPECTIONS AND ANCILLARY WORK TASK WERE COMPLETED SAFELY AND ON TIME.
